## TITLE 16 PROFESSIONAL AND VOCATIONAL REGULATIONS DIVISION 10. DENTAL BOARD OF CALIFORNIA

### **MODIFIED TEXT**

Proposed amendments to the regulatory language are shown in single <u>underline</u> for new text and single <u>strikethrough</u> for deleted text.

Amend Sections 1031 of Division 10 of Title 16 of the California Code of Regulations to read as follows:

### § 1031. Supplemental Examinations in California Law and Ethics.

Prior to issuance of a license, an applicant shall <u>achieve a criterion-referenced</u> <u>passing score on the successfully complete</u> supplemental written examinations in California law and ethics.

- (a) The examination on California law shall test the applicant's knowledge of California law as it relates to the practice of dentistry.
- (b) The examination on ethics shall test the applicant's ability to recognize and apply ethical principles as they relate to the practice of dentistry.
- A candidate shall be deemed to have passed the examinations if his/her score is at least 75% in each examination. As used in this section, "criterion-referenced passing score" is a passing score for the examination established by the modified Angoff standard setting method. This method includes the use of licensees representing the practice of dentistry and a test development specialist and determines through evaluation and rating of each exam question that the passing score represents entry level competence to practice in the profession as specified in subsections (a) and (b).
