
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Assembly Bill 526 (Stats. 2021, Ch. 653) authorized a dentist, if the dentist complies with specified requirements, to independently prescribe and administer influenza and COVID-19 vaccines approved or authorized by the United States Food and Drug Administration for persons three years of age or older, as specified. In this deemed emergency pursuant to Business and Professions Code section 1625.6, the Dental Board of California is adopting regulations to implement these provisions, including requirements pertaining to training, recordkeeping, and reporting.

OAL approves this emergency regulatory action pursuant to sections 11346.1 and 11349.6 of the Government Code.

This emergency regulatory action is effective on 6/23/2022 and will expire on 2/22/2023. The Certificate of Compliance for this action is due no later than 2/21/2023.
